Planning for Next Year

If you know of any children who will be 5 years old by the end of 2026, please remind their parents to get their child registered at their neighborhood school as soon as possible. Please go to <http://www.sd33.bc.ca/e-registration>.

Looking at the other end of the elementary years, due to enrolment pressures across our District, transition to Middle School is based on catchment area, not simply school of attendance. Grade Five students in our English program that live within the Cheam catchment area will automatically transition to Rosedale Traditional Community School. If you do not reside within our catchment, you will need to register at your catchment area Middle School.

Our Grade Five *French Immersion* students will automatically transition to Chilliwack Middle School, regardless of where you reside. If you are thinking of attending a different Middle School, you need to apply online. I suggest you do so ASAP.
